

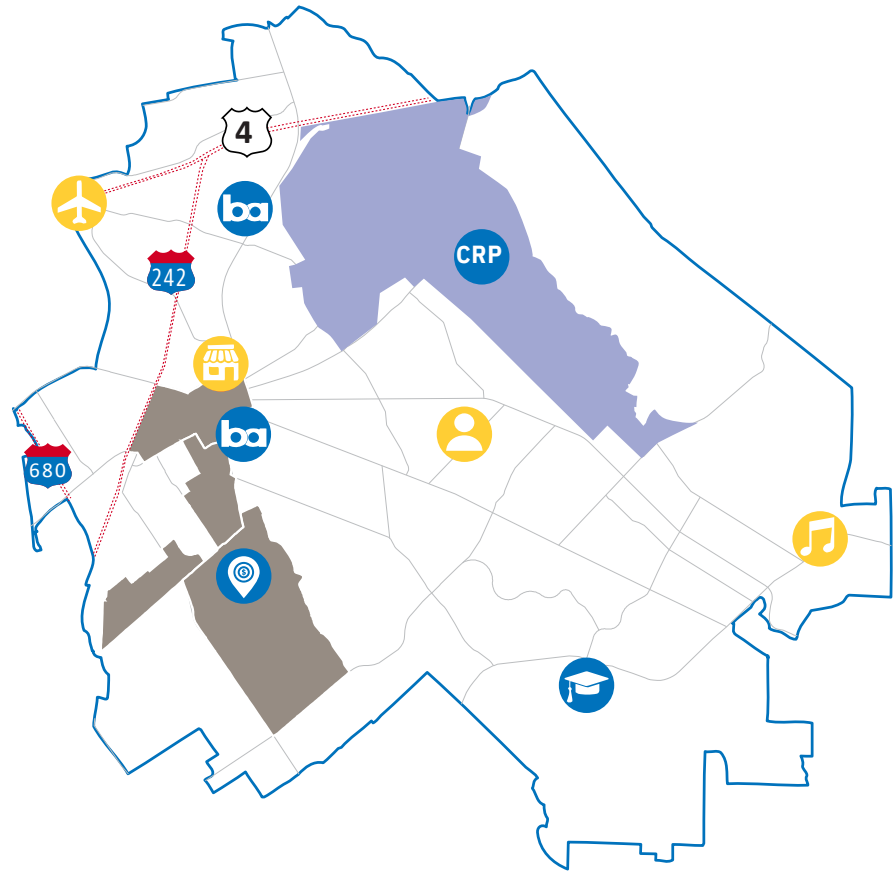

POINTS OF INTEREST

- 
Buchanan Field Airport
 General aviation airport serviced by JSX, with flights to Burbank, Las Vegas, and Orange County.
- 
BART Stations
 Downtown Concord and North Concord BART Stops along the SFO-Millbrae line. About 30 minutes to Oakland and 45 minutes to SF.
- 
Todos Santos Plaza
 Historic downtown with retail. Walkable to BART and 1.5 million square feet of Class A office space.
- 
Opportunity Zones
 Concord has four qualified Opportunity Zones (grey on map). Investors can defer tax on prior gains invested in a Qualified Opportunity Fund.
- 
Local Talent Pool
 Concord has an abundant skilled working population. With 37% of Concord residents commuting to other Bay Area locations, many of your employees already live here!

- 
Concord Reuse Project
 Approximately 2,300 acres (purple on map) of the former Concord Naval Weapons Station will be developed into 12,272 housing units and 6.1 million square feet of mixed-use, commercial, and campus uses.

Toyota Pavilion at Concord
 Amphitheater and live music venue for national touring acts with the capacity to hold 12,500 people.
- 
CSU East Bay
 386-acre CSU East Bay center in Concord that offers both undergraduate and graduate programs.

DRIVING DISTANCE

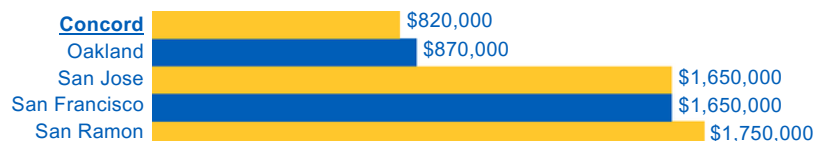
Concord is within driving distance of major Bay Area cities and Sacramento.
